PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Our Mission

To provide free, professional home cleaning services to cancer patients in Massapequa and Seaford, bringing comfort and relief during one of life's most challenging times.

Our Story

Since founding Blessed Cleaning Services Corp. in 2008, Zuleima Trujillo has quietly donated professional home cleanings to cancer patients in her community. What began as individual acts of kindness is now being formalized as the "Blessed to Bless Program" — a structured initiative to ensure that this support reaches more patients consistently and sustainably.

Why "Blessed to Bless"?

The name reflects Zuleima's personal philosophy: the blessings she has received through her business, she passes forward to others. Every cleaning donated is a way of sharing that blessing with someone who needs it most.

Service Area

Massapequa, North Massapequa, Seaford, and surrounding communities within the Town of Oyster Bay, Long Island, NY.

Program Commitment

Blessed Cleaning Services Corp. donates 2 free professional home cleanings per month to cancer patients in the community. All labor and supplies are provided at no cost to the recipient.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for a free cleaning through the Blessed to Bless Program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Resident of Massapequa, Seaford, or surrounding areas within the Town of Oyster Bay
- Currently undergoing active cancer treatment (chemotherapy, radiation, surgery, or immunotherapy) OR recovering within the last 3 months of completing treatment
- Physician verification of diagnosis and treatment status is required
- Open to all regardless of cancer type, age, gender, race, or income level
- One application per household

Priority Consideration

Priority is given to patients living alone or with limited support systems, ensuring that those with the greatest need receive assistance first.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

The Blessed to Bless Program follows a straightforward, six-step process:

1. **Application Submitted:** An application is sent on behalf of the patient by a patient, caregiver, family member, or healthcare provider.
2. **Application Reviewed:** Each application is reviewed for completeness and eligibility.
3. **Medical Verification:** The treating physician must confirm the patient's diagnosis and treatment status.
4. **Recipient Selected:** Recipients are selected based on need and urgency — not by random drawing.
5. **Cleaning Scheduled:** A cleaning date is arranged at the recipient's convenience.
6. **Professional Cleaning:** The Blessed Cleaning Services team provides a thorough professional cleaning.

What Each Recipient Receives

- 2 FREE professional home cleanings (1 per month for 2 consecutive months)
- All cleaning supplies and equipment provided
- Service performed by fully insured professionals

Rolling Admissions: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis throughout the year — there is no quarterly deadline.

Who Can Submit an Application?

- The patient themselves
- A family member or caregiver
- A doctor, nurse, or social worker (with patient consent)

Required Documents

- Completed application form
- Physician verification letter confirming diagnosis and treatment status

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

The Blessed to Bless Program works with local organizations to identify and refer eligible cancer patients. Our partners support the program through referrals and awareness — not fundraising.

PROGRAM SUSTAINABILITY

Fully Funded by Blessed Cleaning Services Corp.

The Blessed to Bless Program is entirely funded by Blessed Cleaning Services Corp. There are no outside donations required to sustain the program at its current level.

2 Cleanings / Month	24 Cleanings / Year	100% Company Funded
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- All costs — including labor and cleaning supplies — are absorbed by the company
- 2 cleanings per month = 24 cleanings per year donated to cancer patients

Future Growth

- The program may expand in the future through community donations and volunteer support
- Annual review of program capacity and community demand ensures sustainable growth
